

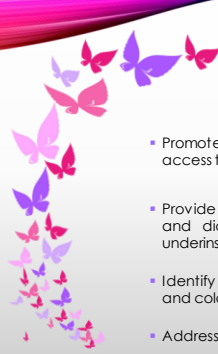

- Promote awareness of screening recommendations and access to screening services
- Provide breast, cervical and colorectal cancer screening and diagnostic testing at no cost for uninsured and underinsured.
- Identify and reduce risks associated with breast, cervical and colorectal health.
- Address disparities and barriers to screening and care

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR SERVICES?

- ✓ 21 and older for cervical cancer screening
- ✓ 40 and older for breast cancer screening
- ✓ Any age with signs/symptoms of breast cancer
- ✓ 45-75 for colorectal cancer screening
- ✓ No Health Insurance or Underinsured
- ✓ ≤250% of Federal Income Guidelines (≤300% for colorectal cancer screening)
- ✓ Patient navigation only for insured women through Care for Yourself

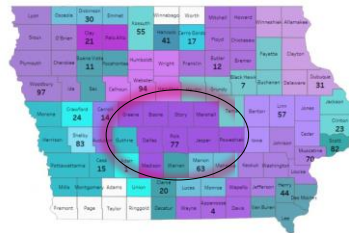

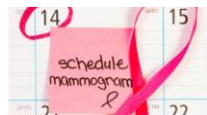

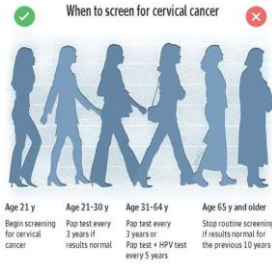
