RINO 2.0 Pros and Cons	
PROS	CONS
At the time of the RINO 2.0 upgrade, there was a need for easy communication/patching between PSAPs that couldn't be met with existing systems. The upgrade met this need.	There is no longer a need for RINO 2.0 as there is the ability to use a regional or subregional calling talkgroup or core resource patch to offer many solutions that were not available when RINO 2.0 was implemented
Determine whether there are other uses (CAD/RMS), but most likely a different funding stream	RINO 2.0 is no longer needed for radio.
	Is the money being spent on RINO 2.0 being spent judiciously?
****Operations MUST be on board to get rid of RINO 2.0 before a recommendation is made to the 911 Executive Committee.****
