RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Polk and Story counties have joint drainage districts and the Board of Supervisors in each county act as trustees for joint drainage districts including Polk Story No. 2; and

WHEREAS, ongoing maintenance is needed to the Drainage District, Polk Story No. 2; and

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed in the account to pay for the current and future ongoing maintenance in Drainage District Polk Story No. 2.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Polk County Board of Supervisors, as joint trustees of Polk Story No. 2 approve an assessment of 16% of the original assessment (\$8,785.25) be spread against all properties lying within the boundaries of Drainage District Polk Story No. 2; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Polk County Auditor is hereby instructed to spread a special assessment equal to 16% of the original \$8,785.25 to be collected in one installment with the taxes due in September 2025.

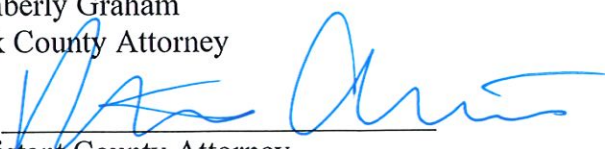

Background: Drainage District Polk Story No. 2 is a joint drainage district and the Board of Supervisors in each county act as trustees for the drainage district. Maintenance was needed recently that the district does not have the funds to fully cover. In order to provide the needed funds and future funds for ongoing maintenance a levy totaling \$5,105.68 has been requested by Story County as the controlling entity. The funds needed equal 16% of the original \$31,910.49 drainage district assessment. The breakdown of the proposed assessment within each county is (Polk County \$667.79, Story County \$4,437.89)

Action Impact: Provides the funding necessary to pay for the current and future district maintenance and instructs the Polk County Auditor to do a special mailing so that the assessment is collected with taxes.
